My summers as a student at Meadowmount had a profound impact on me – not only because of the musical experiences and lifelong friendships, but because it was also when I first met Mr. Gingold, who would become my beloved private teacher for many years. His humanity, generous spirit, and deep love of music still influence me today, as it did for countless musicians for whom he was a cherished teacher, mentor, chamber coach, and friend.

We will also be welcoming the Grammy Award-winning Kronos Quartet to our campus this summer. Renowned for revolutionizing the string quartet genre through over 50 years of bold innovation, the Kronos Quartet will begin its Meadowmount residency with a concert on July 28, indicating a landmark moment in our school's history.

Lastly, I hope you will join us for our Benefit Concert on Sunday, August 3, where faculty and guest artists will once again collaborate with the talented young musicians at Meadowmount for a celebratory performance.

We are thrilled you are joining us to experience inspiring "Music from Meadowmount" and look forward to welcoming you throughout this summer.

ABOUT MEADOWMOUNT



Founded in 1944 by legendary violin teacher Ivan Galamian, the Meadowmount School of Music is a seven-week summer program for violinists, violists, and cellists. Musicians ages 10 to 30 from around the world gather at the school's campus in the Adirondack Mountains in northern New York to immerse themselves in an environment where they can focus on personal and artistic development through intensive training with leading faculty, individual practice, chamber music, and performance opportunities.

Meadowmount has long been regarded as the premier destination for young musicians and has helped create some of the greatest artists of our time. Meadowmount alumni are well represented internationally among soloists and chamber musicians, principal players of leading orchestras, and distinguished teachers. Notable alumni include Itzhak Perlman, Yo-Yo Ma, Pinchas Zukerman, Jessie Montgomery, Kyung-Wha Chung, Lynn Harrell, Joshua Bell, Jaime Laredo, James Ehnes, and Ani and Ida Kavafian, among others.

With a capacity enrollment of 190 on the 49-building, 240-acre campus, the school retains an intimacy that provides for personal attention and fosters camaraderie among the students. Many students return year after year and alumni retain strong connections and return as faculty and guest artists, ensuring the continuity of the Meadowmount teaching tradition. The faculty roster that has over the years included Gregor Piatigorsky, Josef Gingold, Isaac Stern, Leonard Rose, Sally Thomas, and Dorothy DeLay, has recently featured violinists Ann Setzer, Gerardo Ribeiro, I-Hao Lee, Paul Kantor, and Janet Sung, violists Ayane Kozasa and Caroline Coade, and cellists Hans Jørgen Jensen and Thomas Landschoot – a lineage that is unmatched in the field.

REMEMBERING JOSEF GINGOLD (1909 - 1995)



2025 marks the 30th anniversary of Josef Gingold's death on January 11, 1995. A student of Eugene Ysaÿe, he is remembered as one of the most influential violin teachers of the 20th Century – his noted students include Joshua Bell, Andrés Cárdenes, Leonidas Kavakos, Miriam Fried, Jaime Laredo, and Janet Sung. A renowned pedagogue and colleague of Meadowmount's founder, Ivan Galamian, Mr. Gingold taught at the Meadowmount School of Music for 25 summers.

A distinguished concert artist, he performed in the NBC Symphony Orchestra under the direction of Arturo Toscanini and was a founding member of the Primrose String Quartet. Mr. Gingold also performed as concertmaster of the Detroit Symphony before joining the Cleveland Orchestra and remaining its concertmaster for 13 years, a position he accepted at the request of legendary conductor George Szell. As a Professor of Violin and Distinguished Professor Emeritus of Music, He taught at the Jacobs School of Music at Indiana University for over 30 years.
